The Huntington Orchid Show:

This year's show will be Oct 16-18th. It will be different this year because of Covid19. There will be no vendors, no orchid hotel, and no judging and will be held outdoors protected from direct sun. We have been asked by the Huntington if our Society would like to display Orchids. This is a good opportunity for our members to show off their Orchids. We have seen some really nice entries for Show-N-Tell, so I know you have beautiful Orchids.

Tom and Ron will take two vehicles to transport the society's orchids to the Huntington on Thursday, October 15. Please contact Ron or Linda if you think you will have any orchids (ones that will be ok outdoors protected from direct sun).

Here are the Details:

- 1. You will need to make arrangements with Ron and Linda Lang 951 663 5234 or notarylinda@hotmail.com by October 10 if you will have plants to enter.**
- 2. Orchid Pick up will be either on Wed. October 14 or Thursday morning October 15.**
- 3. The orchids should be double potted, groomed and clean ready to be placed in the show.**
- 4. Your Orchids will be returned on Sunday October 18.**
- 5. Again you will need to make arrangements with Ron and Linda Lang ASAP.**

The orchids will NOT be judged due to the limitations of the virus that has affected us all. The plants will be exhibited as individual plants to show off the beauty of the individual orchid.

We will need to know by October 10 an approximate number of plants that you may wish to send to the show so that we can reserve the tables we will need.

The plants will be exhibited outside under a cover to prevent direct sun.

This is an important opportunity for our orchid society to show support for the Huntington and to advertise our society. We look forward to your entries. Please let us know as soon as possible.
