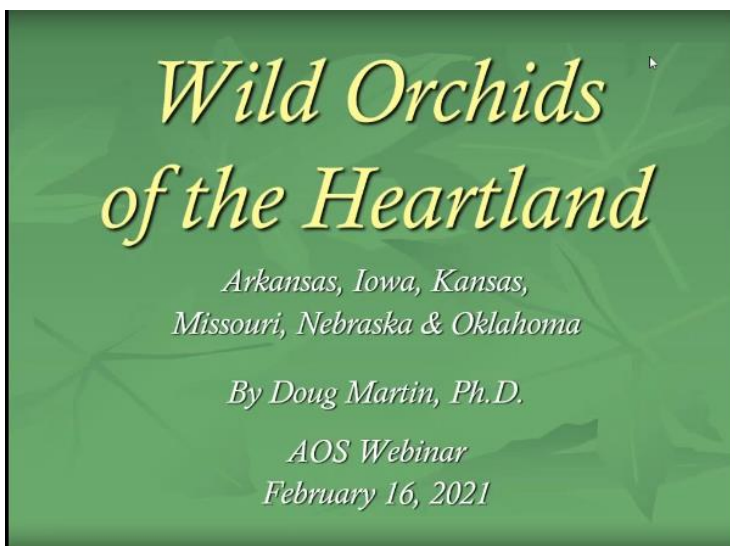

He retired in 2016 from teaching chemistry at Penn Valley Community College in Kansas City. He opened a lab – Biosource Orchid Lab to do seed flasking and stem propagation for orchid growers in 1992. 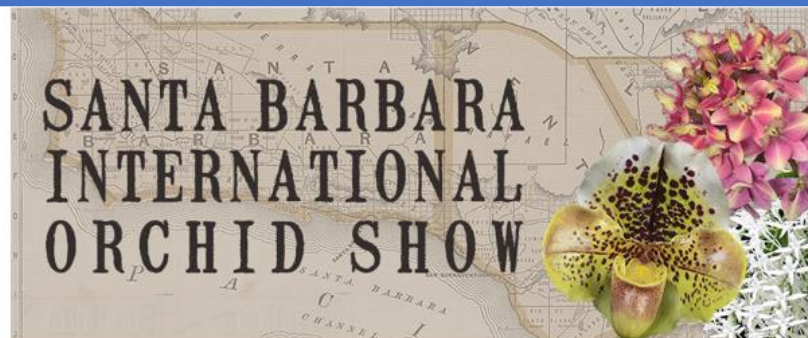

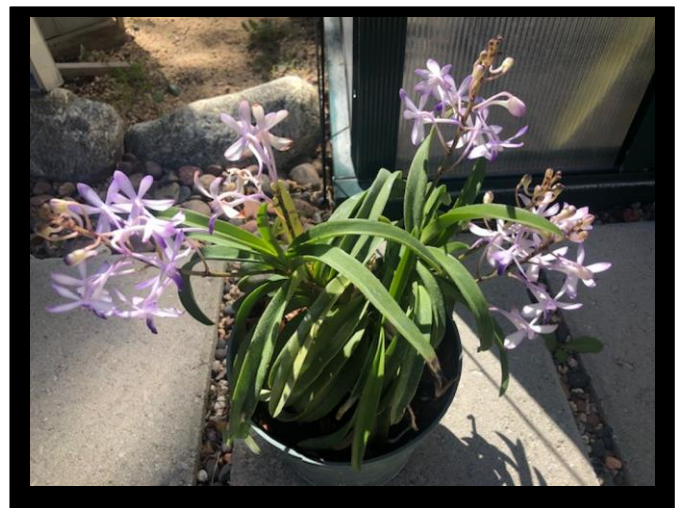

The board meetings are held on the fourth Sunday of the month and the general society membership is always welcome. If you are a board member and you are not able to attend, please notify Tom Gibbs

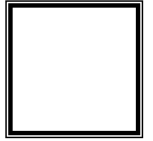
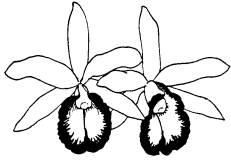

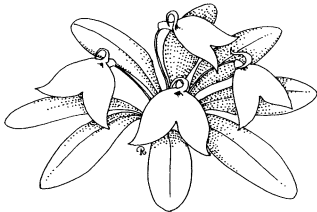
