He received his M.S. degree at San Diego State University where he completed his thesis "Comparative Floristic Study of Palomar Mountain State Park". During his thesis he began to study terrestrial orchids which created a specific interest, leading him to further his education. He is currently a PhD candidate at Rancho Santa Ana Botanic Garden and will be completing his dissertation soon. His dissertation focuses on a native California genus of terrestrial orchids known as Piperia. His study also has enabled him to grow and work with numerous tropical and terrestrial orchids native to North America, South America, Africa and Europe. Many of these orchids are beautiful and easy to grow here in Southern California. Bob will be discussing the genus Zygo.
