We are pleased to have Mr. Fred Clarke from Sunset Valley Orchids as our speaker for the January meeting. Fred Clarke started Sunset Valley Orchids in 1995 as a natural outgrowth of a hobby that began 27 years earlier. Sunset Valley Orchids is a "Boutique" style nursery where we are dedicated to providing excellent customer service and breeding superior orchid hybrids for the orchid enthusiast. Sunset Valley Orchids is located in Vista, California about 35 miles north of San Diego and 50 miles south of Los Angeles. The nursery has grown considerably over the last few years and we are now exceeding 45,000 sq. ft. of greenhouses space.

SVO are plant breeders of award quality orchids and their efforts are focused in the development of new and interesting lines. They provide unique hybrids and species in several genera including; Cattleya, Catasetinae, Paphiopedilum, Australian Native Dendrobium, and a few others in limited numbers like Sarcochilus, Zygopetalum and Stanhopea. All our plant offerings are produced in our laboratory and grown from seed here at the nursery. The lab processes over 200 new hybrids annually resulting is 2000 re-plate flasks.

SVO plants are selected on strict criteria of robust growth and ease to flower. This is accomplished by selecting the most vigorous growing plants throughout the growing process of; flasking, community trays, and growing on in pots. This grading results in the strongest and best plants for both customers and for their own future breeding.

Fred is a popular speaker on many orchid subjects and travels extensively around the United States, Canada, Australia, New Zealand, South Africa, Latin and South America. He is available to give talks and provide plant tables to Orchid Societies and Garden Clubs. Sunset Valley Orchids is open most Saturdays, Sundays and by appointment.

Fred is an accredited American Orchid Society Judge in the Pacific South Judging Region. Orchids from Sunset Valley Orchid have received hundreds of AOS awards, including 8 that have received the highest honor, the 'First Class Certificate'.

Fred's topic for the night will be Australian Dendrobiums and Sunset Valley Orchids will be furnishing the opportunity table. Make sure to get lots of raffle tickets as these orchids are wonderful.






