Vendors of the Month

We appreciate the years of support of donations for our annual fund-raising Orchid auction. We will feature two vendors that support us each month so that you may not only be familiar with them but purchase some great plants and supplies. At least you can go online and dream of that orchid that would really look nice in your collection.

1) Fred Clarke of Sunset Valley Orchids in Vista, CA is dedicated to breeding new hybrid low growing orchids. They concentrate their efforts to three areas of developing orchid plants for your pleasure. The three areas are to breed for early to bloom, compact plants and develop newer flower colors and shapes. They have been breeding Cattleya for forty years and have hundreds of AOS awards. They have a wide variety of orchid hybrids besides Cattleya so check out their web site.

They do not breed for mass market sales but for the orchid Enthusiast, and sell orchids worldwide. All his orchids are grown from seed to blooming size plants. The plants must pass a rigorous test before they are offered on the market. The prices are reasonable. Fred Clarke will be our electronic speaker for the June meeting, you will not want to miss his talk.

If you wish to visit the nursery, you must make an appointment by calling Fred Clarke at 760-310-0778. Look up this nursery by searching Sunset Valley Orchids.

2) Gubler Orchids is a family owned and ran business in Landers, CA. It is closed to the public at this time and you may check online when it reopens for your private purchases of orchids and supplies. With the cooperation and partnership of Chris Gubler we put on the AOS orchid show at the Morongo Basin Orchid Festival in October.

Gubler Orchids was opened in 1918 by Heir Gubler. It was his second son that moved to California in 1954 and started Gubler Orchids by selling orchids from his station wagon. If you are interested in seeing some of his orchids go to your local Lowes store, the orchids are supplied by Gubler Orchids. You may also purchase your Gubler orchid fertilizer at the same store.

When we are no longer in lock down you may visit the Landers location to purchase plants and orchid supplies. Gubler Orchids has been a great supporter of The Riverside/San Bernardino Counties Orchid Society.

We extend our appreciation to these two orchid businesses and their support of our society. Give them a look online. You may find something that your spouse, friend or just a neighbor cannot live without.

The next board meeting will be a virtual Zoom meeting on June 28th at 3:30 PM.


The board meetings are held on the fourth Sunday of the month and the general society membership is always welcome. If you are a board member and you are not able to attend, please notify Tom Gibbs


