Orchid Tips:

GROW *BLETILLA STRIATA* CHINESE GROUND ORCHID:

Chinese Ground orchids are terrestrial orchids and can be grown in the ground or in pots filled with soil. I grow mine in pots using Miracle Grow potting soil blended with Perlite. These orchids are native to Asia. The foliage dies for the winter and regrows in the spring. They bloom for about one month in early to midsummer. When the plant has no leaves do not water them. Resume watering when the leaves appear in the Spring. For detailed culture look on the internet or talk to Jamie Stewart.

Repotting Tip:

Do you have an orchid that has overgrown its plastic pot and needs to be repotted into a larger pot? You can use a wood burning iron to carefully cut through the plastic pot. Now slip pot the orchid into the new pot. Some orchids do not like to be disturbed and this is an easy way to repot without disturbing the orchid plant.

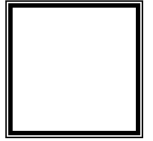
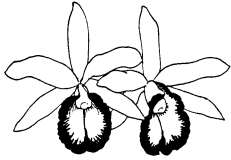

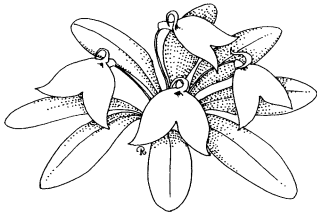
