# **California Garden Clubs Inc. President's Project:**

Why should we be interested in the CGCI President's Project? First, we are members of CGCI and get various benefits. One of the greatest benefits is that together as a group of clubs a great deal more may be accomplished. The CGCI president has set a goal for her project of \$20,000 over the next two years. This translates that if all the CGCI clubs participate, the goal can be reached to enhance and preserve 52 miles along the San Diego River in the city of San Diego. Work has already begun on building a visitor center and educational facilities. The land along the river has been purchased and is secure from further development. The area will be developed with hiking trails, natural areas, theme gardens, park areas and educational buildings. The park will serve seniors, youth and families living near the area as well as visitors to San Diego.

Linda Lang asked the head of this project during his presentation to the Winter CGCI Board meeting "How many native orchids were found in this area?". This question resulted in a future survey of the area to answer this question. There are approximately 16 native orchids in San Diego County itself.

What can we do? To start with, we have a \$50 matching fund that lasts until August 1, 2022. The Board voted to accept this challenge with funds donated from individuals in the society. There will be no funds for this challenge coming from the general fund. This is your opportunity to contribute to native orchid conservation in our backyard as well as exposing youth to the natural world. The Board may choose to donate from the general fund later. Send your checks to our treasurer Steve Trammell, or when you see Steve, you may use your personal credit card.

### **Show-N-Tell:**

Show-N-Tell will not be judged at the March board meeting. We will have our in-person Show-N-Tell at the April 9<sup>th</sup> meeting. Bring all your blooming orchids to our April meeting.

### **New Show-N-Tell Judging Category:**

The Board has added a new entry category to include specimen plants that are too large to get to the meetings. They will be judged at the regular meeting from photos that you have sent to Steve Trammell by the 5<sup>th</sup> of each month. We are planning on projecting these pictures on a screen to be judged.

Steve Trammell and Ron Lang presented a program on caring for orchids to the newly founded Banning Estates Garden Club in Banning. A great thanks to Steve and the program he has developed for interested groups. This is one way to get the word out about our society.




