Hunting Orchids in the Sky Islands Scenic Byway. Presenter: Ben Rostron PhD.



Ben Rostron is a Professor in the Department of Earth and Atmospheric Sciences at the University of Alberta. His hobbies include photography and hunting for native orchids in North America and beyond. He has taken trips to Australia and China looking for orchids. He is an accrediated AOS judge. He still finds time to nurture a small collection of Phalaenopsis species that includes amboinensis, bellina and violacea.

This program is a recording of a presentation to the Native Orchid Conference in 2022. I had no idea that there were so many wonderful orchids growing wild in this location.

Orchid Growing Tips:

Recycle and Save money, all you need is an empty soup container and a wood burning set.



Step 1. Eat the soup, wash the container.

Step 2. Using a wood burning set, make slits running up and down the container.

Step 3. Using the wood burning set, make drain holes in the bottom of the container.

Step 4. Repot your Orchid.

Notes: I am planning on using these free pots to repot some of my Phalaenopsis Orchids. The clear pots let me see the roots. When the roots turn a whitish color, I know it is time to water. If roots start to die, I can see this also. Free pots are always good – more money for more orchids.
