Culture of Chinese Ground Orchids Bletilla striata:

This orchid requires well drained soil. It may be grown in the ground or in a pot. I have not attempted to grow this orchid in the ground but have had great success in a six-inch plastic pot. I have planted my new ones in 8-inch clay pots, we shall see. The plastic may keep the moisture better. This orchid requires bright light but not full sun. They may thrive in shade but are not likely to bloom. My pots are in an area where water runs off from the water system and runs under the pots that are surrounded by debris and compost. The roots have gone out of the pot and have spread out under the compost. Transplanting should take place after flowering. In the fall the foliage will die off and the plant will be dormant. At that time water lightly. Use soil that is well drained and you may add some compost to the soil before planting. These orchids are available from many nurseries online. For further information ask Jamie Stewart at our regular orchid meeting and he may have a few of the purple ones to sell you. Information from the internet.

The next board meeting will be a virtual Zoom meeting on May21 at 3:30 PM


The board meetings are held on the fourth Sunday of the month and the general society membership is always welcome. If you are a board member and you are not able to attend, please notify Tom Gibbs


