Riverside-San Bernardino Counties Orchid Society (RSBCOS) was founded to further the understanding and appreciation of orchids by its members locally and to aid in a worldwide effort to improve man's knowledge of them.

There are a lot of growers out there and most sell on the internet. This would be a chance for us to have a larger variety of plants or orchid supplies on the table. September Program:



This is a recorded program that was presented March 15, 2023. This program was sponsored by the American Orchid Society. Jacqui Bowman is the director of education at the Mütter Museum College of Physicians of Philadelphia. She thinks that the connection between plants and healing has been lost for many people. The Mütter Museum's goal is to give new life to the founding father's medicinal gardens. The idea for the garden goes back to Benjamin Rush. This garden is named after Dr. Rush, a signer of the Declaration of Independence and co-founder of the College of Physicians in Philadelphia. Rush wanted to have an in-house source of medicinal remedies. The College was founded in 1787, however it was not until 1937 that the Benjamin Rush Garden was envisioned. This is a very interesting presentation which talks about the garden and the use of dendrobiums for medicinal purposes.

October Meeting Cancelled

Yes, the October meeting has been cancelled by the Board. The Gonzales Community Center had some other event happening on the second Saturday. Since we have the Morongo Basin Orchid Festival and the Huntington International Orchid Show in October the board made the decision to cancel. We need members to help at both of these shows, come join other members and meet members from other southern California orchid societies. We need your blooming orchids for both shows. Plants from members on exhibit will be judged and receive points for Show-N-Tell. Also, both shows are great places to add orchids to your collection.

Morongo Basin Orchid Festival

Our society is hosting the AOS Orchid show at this event October 7 - 8, 2023.

SETUP: Friday, October 6th 12 noon - 4:00 pm. We will start setting up the show on Friday Oct. 6

at noon. If you can help that day, it would be greatly appreciated. Orchid plants may be

entered at that time and will be placed as soon as the staging is completed.

DESIGNS: You may construct your designs on Friday after 1:30 pm or Saturday from 8 am – 9:30

am. There will be containers for you to borrow as well as some greenery available for line material. Orchid flowers are provided by Gubler's Orchids. Orchids must be the dominant plant material in each design. It is a designer's choice so let your creativity shine. There will be two classes, petite and standard designs. The Petite will range from 3 inch to 8 inch (your choice). If you wish to make a design, please contact Linda Lang

at (951) 663-5237 to be sure we have enough space.

PLANT ENTRIES: Friday, October 6th after setup is complete (12 noon - 4:00 pm). Also, you will be able to

enter your plants on Saturday, October 7th from 8 am to 9:45 am.

JUDGING: Judging will begin Saturday October 7 at 10 am. Bring your blooming orchid plants and

the AOS judges will pick out the plants that will be judged for AOS awards.

VOLUNTEERS: We need volunteers to help set up on Friday October 6 starting at noon.

We need volunteers to help place plants in the entire display to give the best view to the

public.

We need volunteers to host and answer questions from the guests visiting our show on

Saturday, 10:00 am - 4:00 pm and on Sunday, 10:00 am to 3:00 pm.

We will especially need hosts on Saturday and Sunday from 11:30 am-1:30 pm while

four of us will be conducting the orchid design classes.

Volunteers needed to take down show on Sunday, starting at 3:00pm.

This is our show. Please bring those blooming orchids or make arrangements for them to be picked up and entered for you in the show. A show without workers and orchids is not a show. See you there.

If you have orchids to send to this show but cannot deliver them yourself, please reach out to Ron Lang, Steve Trammell, or Tom Gibbs. We will work with you to get your orchids to the show.


Board Meeting
