Program for December 12th

Peter Lin will be our speaker. If you have not met or heard Peter speak, let me describe what you will experience. Peter is like a Christmas tree – familiar, bright, colorful, refreshing, long history with orchids, warm and above all a speaker whose presentation will linger in your memory for a long time. Peter is an orchid grower, orchid hybridizer, American Orchid Society Judge and vendor. He specializes in Mini Cattleya Orchids, both species and hybrids. He maintains a collection of over 1000 orchids of various species and hybrids. He is knowledgeable about orchids and puts aside orchid jargon and speaks a language we all can understand about how to grow, how to get them to bloom with a few scientific facts thrown in so that you may impress your friends with your knowledge of orchids.

Peter has been our orchid auctioneer for our annual fund-raising orchid auction held each spring. Our auction for 2020 will be held March 21 at the Lawrence Hutton Community Center from 10 am to 2 pm. We appreciate Peter for helping us out each year with his knowledge and auctioneering ability.

Peter's presentation will be on the Japan Grand Prix International Orchid Show. The Japan Grand Prix International Orchid Festival started in 1991. Thanks to your support and cooperation, the festival has developed into a flower event drawing international attention as a harbinger of the arrival of spring. We are aiming to be a bridge for international exchange and familiarization and the improvement of breeding technology through the exhibition of orchids from Japan and abroad. This festival was held in February 2019 at the Tokyo Dome, Tokyo, Japan.

This is a program that you will not want to miss, and the snacks are good as well.

Christmas Potluck – December 12th

We will be hosting our annual holiday potluck celebration on Thursday, Dec. 12, 2020. Our potluck stands out from all the other seasonal potlucks you will be attending this month. Our President, Tom Gibb, will be bringing his famous and sought-after apple pie. **The potluck starts at 6 pm with set up at 5:30 pm.** There also will an **in-house orchid show-n-tell.** Please bring your blooming orchids to share and be judged.

Nessa Rosenbaum Memorial

We will be sending \$270 to the Orchid Conservancy in memory of Nessa Rosenbaum, a longtime member of our society. The Orchid Conservancy is purchasing orchid habitat in Brazil and nearby countries to preserve and maintain native orchids for the future. The Conservancy also offers tours in that area to see firsthand the native orchids growing in their natural habitat as well as the variety of wildlife native to the areas. We want to thank all who donated and supported this important memorial.

Reaching Beyond Ourselves

The Society board has voted to give a \$500 scholarship to a deserving student majoring in Ornamental Horticulture, preferably orchids. We will limit this scholarship to university or college sophomores and above. The board is exploring nearby, or in San Bernardino or Riverside County, university or college which offers this major. The details are still in process. If you are aware of such an institution, please let one of the board members know. We have set aside \$500 from the \$1,550 received from the Morongo Basin Orchid Festival in Landers. Our share of the festival proceeds was \$500 plus \$1050 from the two orchid design classes put on by members of our society. We want to thank Chris Gubler of Gubler's Orchids for his generosity and support of our society.




