The plan is for everyone to have fun, gain confidence in floral design and to realize how creative you are. Join us for a fun filled evening. The designs will not be judged. This program is an opportunity not to be missed.

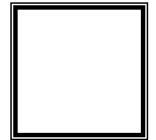

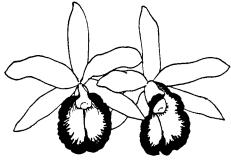

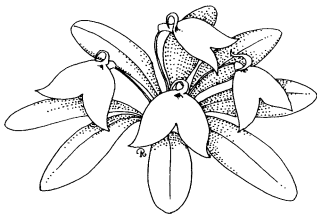
